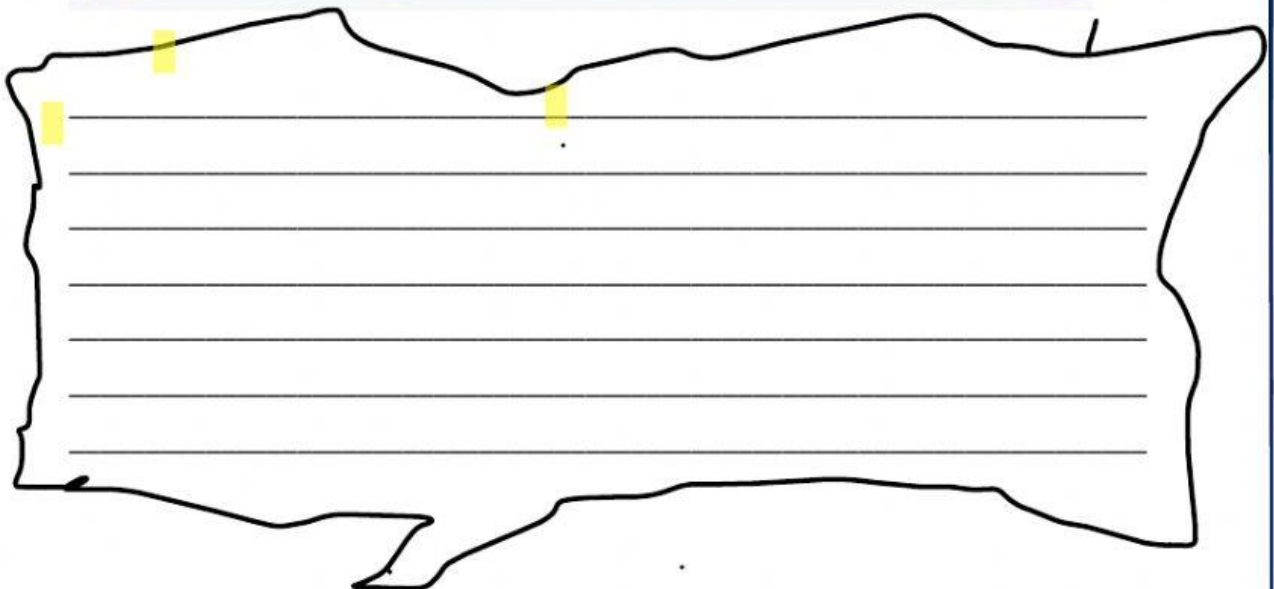
1. **Listen** to Andy talking about his favorite school subject. Choose the answers he gives.
