

How to say years in English

Basically, we tend to read four-digit years as a pair of 2-digit numbers. For example, 1997 is nineteen ninety-seven. We read three-digit years as a pair or the way we count money.

Telephone Numbers in English

In the U.S. phone numbers have seven digits, plus an area code. The number zero ("0") can be pronounced "oh" or "zero." We say the area code as single digits.

If two digits are the same, some people may use "double" to say the same two numbers such as 7700, double seven double oh.

Zero "0" is pronounced either "oh" or "zero."

"Oh" is more common.

Look at how to say measurements.

10mm ten millimetres

10cm ten centimetres

10m ten metres

10m² ten square metres (area)

5×2 five by two (area/cross section)

10m³ ten cubic metres (volume)

Don't use 'of' with units of measurement:

two hundred euros/gigabytes

(NOT of euros/of gigabytes)

Other points

Note the phrase 'on average'.

On average we assemble 80 cars a day.

Note the prepositions in these examples.

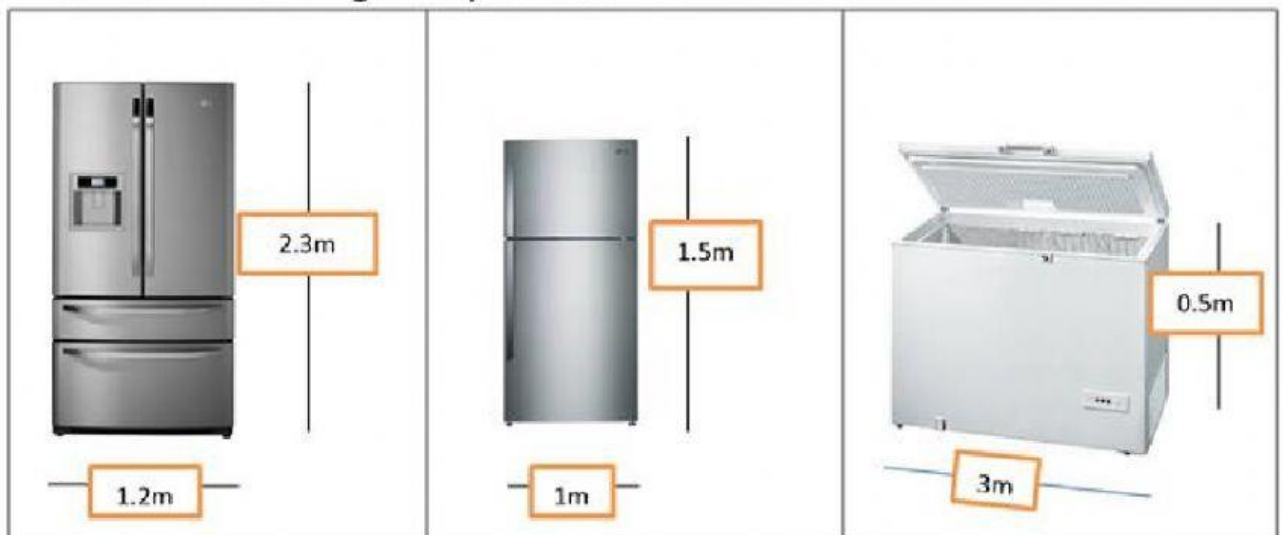
We had an increase ***in*** sales ***of*** 6%.

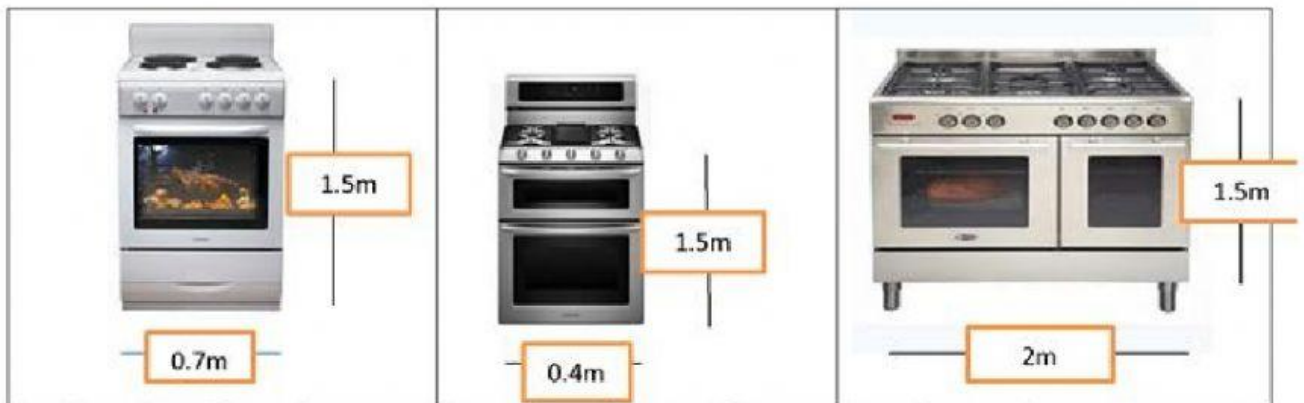
