True-False Statements on Digestive System

Q	Statement	Answer
1	In physical digestion, food is broken down into smaller pieces by mechanical means.	
2	Mouth is the only organ that experiences both physical digestion and chemical digestion.	
3	Carbohydrates break down carbohydrates into simple sugars in the mouth.	
4	At the end of digestion, amino acids, simple sugars and proteins are small enough to be absorbed into the bloodstream.	
5	In the small intestine, lipases digest fats to form glycerol and amino acids.	
6	Starch is digested to form partially digested carbohydrates in the mouth and gullet.	
7	Chemical digestion of fats occurs only in the small intestine.	
8	Proteases digest proteins to form amino acids in the stomach and small intestine	
9	Carbohydrates, proteins and fats are fully digested in the small and large intestines.	
10	Only water is absorbed in the large intestine.
