

The simple present tense: affirmative-negative and question

1. *I usually go to school at 7:30 a.m.*

(-) I.....to school at 7:30 a.m.

(?).....you..... to school at 7:30 a.m?

2. *She washes her hair three times a week.*

(-) She..... her hair three times a week.

(?).....she..... her hair three times a week?

3. *They always go to work by car.*

(-) They to work by car.

(?).....they..... to work by car?

4. *He sometimes gets up late in the morning.*

(-).....late in the morning.

(?).....he.....late in the morning?

5. *Jim often plays football with his friends after school.*

(-) football with his friends after school.

(?).....Jim..... football with his friends after school?

6. *Lan drinks coffee every morning.*

(-) coffee every morning.

(-)Lan..... coffee every morning?

7. *We always have breakfast at home.*

(-)..... breakfast at home.

(?).....you..... breakfast at home?

8. *They usually surf the internet in the evening.*

(-) the internet in the evening.

(?).....they.....the internet in the evening?

9. *He brushes his teeth twice a day.*

(-).....his teeth twice a day.

(?).....he.....his teeth twice a day?

10. *Mary has hamburgers and salad for her breakfast.*

(-).....hamburgers and salad for her breakfast.

(?).....Mary..... hamburgers and salad for her breakfast?
