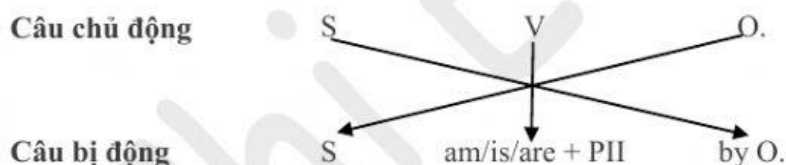

- Cách chuyển từ chủ động sang bị động



**Note:*

- PII - Quá khứ phân từ; O = Object: Tân ngữ
- Trong nhiều trường hợp có thể lược bỏ cụm "by + O", khi tân ngữ câu bị động là: they, people, everyone, someone, anyone, you, ...

2. Reflexive pronoun (Đại từ phản thân)

- Bảng quy đổi đại từ nhân xưng - đại từ phản thân

I	myself	He	himself
You	yourself/yourselves	She	herself
We	ourselves	It	itself
They	themselves		

**Note:* Chúng ta sử dụng đại từ phản thân khi chủ ngữ và tân ngữ trực tiếp của động từ giống nhau


