

PRESENT SIMPLE AND ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

REMEMBER! We use adverbs of frequency with the Present Simple to indicate how often a person does an action.

Adverb of frequency + verb → “I always get up at 8 o'clock”

Verb be + adverbs of frequency → “He is never late”


