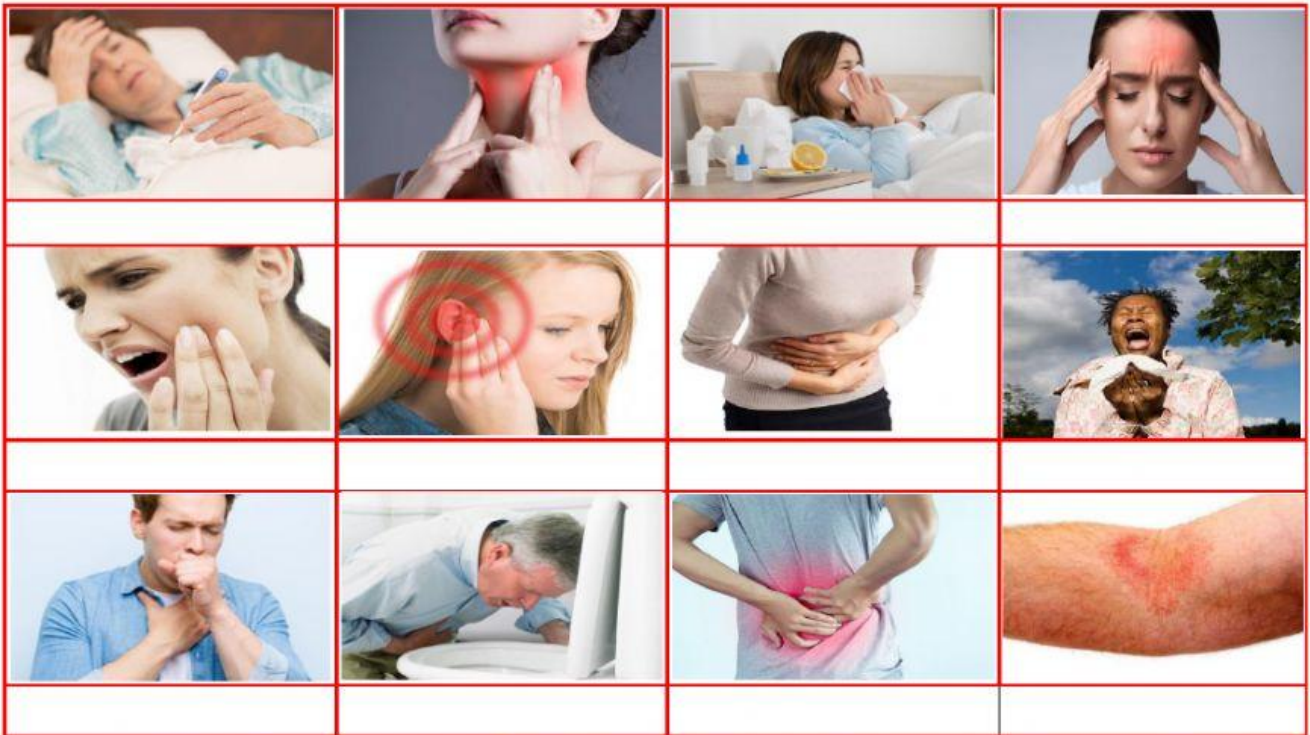

What Do you Know about Elephants?



Elephants are the biggest land animals in the world. We can find the African elephant on the continent of Africa and the Indian elephant in Asia. Elephants are mammals and herbivores. They only eat plants they don't eat meat. The African elephant is bigger than the Indian elephant. Elephants have large, thin ears. They are also clever and sensitive and they have a good memory. Elephants live in family groups. Female elephants give birth to one calf after a twenty-two -month gestation period. And adult elephant weigh 7,500 kilograms and it can be 6.0 to 7.5 metres tall and They *drink* up to 200 litres of *water* a day. They live in the Forest, savannah and flood plains. They have a long trunk and ivory tusks.

These animals can live up to 70 years in the wild.
