


..... is a sadistic, sociopathic, short-tempered, manipulative, treacherous, violent, merciless, mean-spirited, vicious, self-centered, and arrogant carnivore. Despite his ruthless and evil nature, he is something of a coward, more likely to run away from violence than confront it.

..... is known to be an eccentric, yet well-meaning, friend. He is best friends with Otis and most of the other inhabitants of the Barnyard. He also likes to jump around on Otis. He also has more common sense than Otis and often suggests a simple solution to Otis' problems, but Otis usually doesn't listen.

..... was noble, confident, overprotective, loving, strict, tough, courageous, sometimes harsh, fatherly, serious, and did not have much fun.

..... is an older and wisest animal in the Barnyard and he tries his best to keep a level head. Besides Pips, he is sometimes the animal whom Otis talks to for advice. After Ben's death, he, in a way, took over as a father-like figure for Otis. Aside from being calm, level-headed, and fatherly, he is also wise, friendly and helpful.

..... is very sweet, loyal, caring, selfless, honest, and trustworthy. She was the one who encouraged Otis to stay at the Barnyard and protect his best friends, and she even named her child after Ben.
