

UNIT 2: SIMPLE PRESENT

We use the present simple to talk about habits and things that we do regularly.

Example: We walk to school

Affirmative	Negative
I play soccer.	I don't play soccer.
You play soccer.	You don't play soccer.
He plays soccer.	He doesn't play soccer.
She plays soccer.	She doesn't play soccer.
It plays soccer.	It doesn't play soccer.
We play soccer.	We don't play soccer.
They play soccer.	They don't play soccer.

Spelling rules: Look at the spelling rules for he, she, and it forms of the present simple affirmative

Verb	Example	Add	Forms
Most verbs	Get	+ s	Plays
Verbs ending consonant +-y	Study	-y + ies	Studies
Verbs ending -s, -ch, -sh, -x, -o, or -z	Watch	+ es	watches

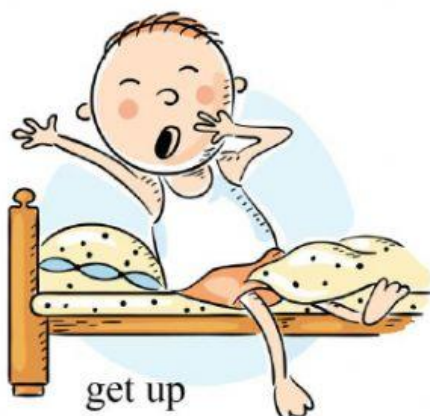
