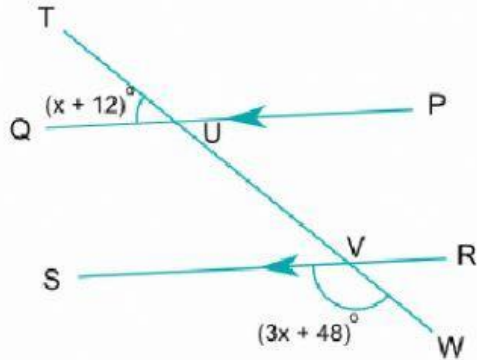

The size of angle TUQ is $(x + 12)^\circ$ and the size of angle SVW is $(3x + 48)^\circ$

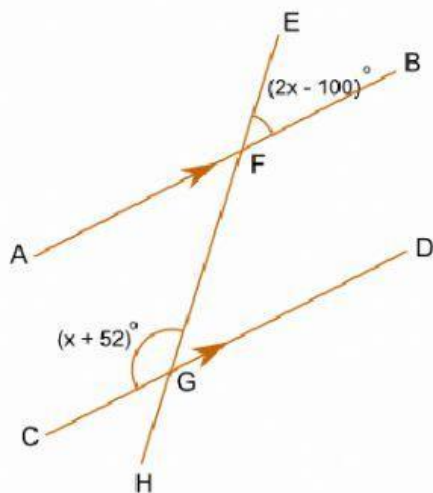
What is the value of x ?

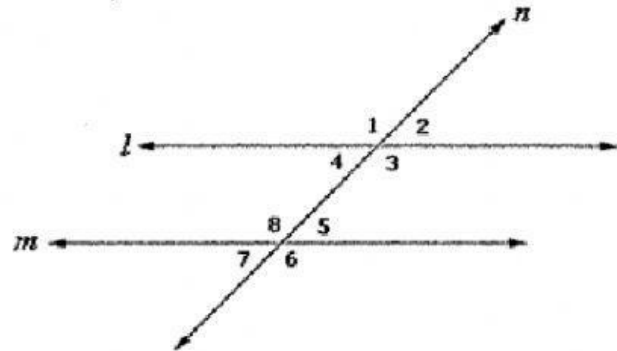
