



A quarter is worth 25 cents.

You can count by 25s to find out how much money you have in quarters.

25, 50, 75, 100, 125, 150, 175, 200...

A quarter is one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of a dollar.

Four quarters is the same as one dollar.


Count \$1.00



**Count \$0.50
(50 cents)**



Count \$0.75





A dime is worth \$0.10 or ten cents

You can count by tens to find out how much money you have in dimes.

10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100

A dime is one tenth of a dollar.

Ten dimes equals one dollar.

**Count \$0.50
(fifty cents)**



**Count \$0.30
(thirty cents)**



**Count \$0.10
(ten cents)**



A nickel is worth \$0.05 or 5 cents.



You can count by fives to find out how much money you have in nickels.

5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50...

A nickel is 1/20 of a dollar or one out of twenty.

20 nickels makes one dollar.

Two nickels makes one dime

Count 0.20



Count 0.10



Count 0.25





**A loonie is worth one dollar or one hundred cents.
You can count by ones to find how much money you have in
loonies. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5...**

Four quarters equals one dollar.

Ten dimes equals one dollar.

Twenty nickels equals one dollar.

A toonie is worth two dollars.

You can count by twos to find out how much money you have in toonies. 2, 4, 6, 8, 10...

Eight quarters make a toonie.

Twenty dimes make a toonie.

Forty nickels make a toonie.
