<p>What is in the picture?</p> <p><i>In the picture, I can see ...</i></p> <p><i>There's / There are ...</i></p> <p><i>There isn't a ... / There aren't any ...</i></p>	<p>Where in the picture?</p> <p><i>At the top/bottom of the picture ...</i></p> <p><i>In the middle of the picture ...</i></p> <p><i>On the left/right of the picture ...</i></p> <p><i>next to, in front of, behind, near, on top of, under</i></p>
