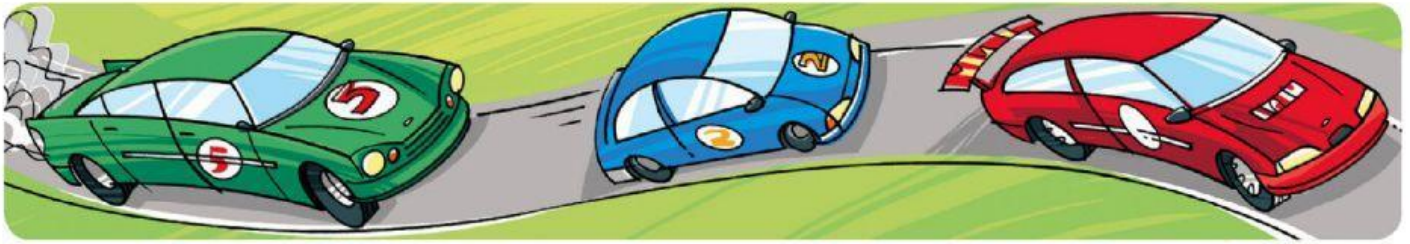


COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVE - The red car is bigger than the blue car.

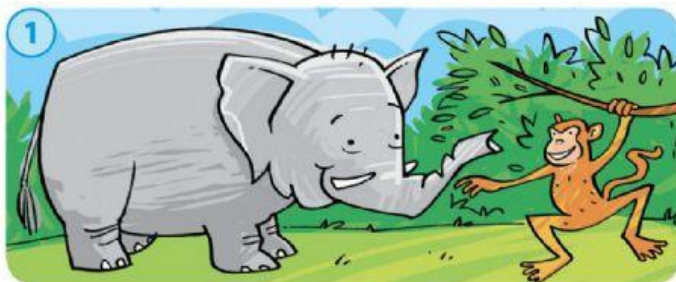
heavy + er ➡ heavier

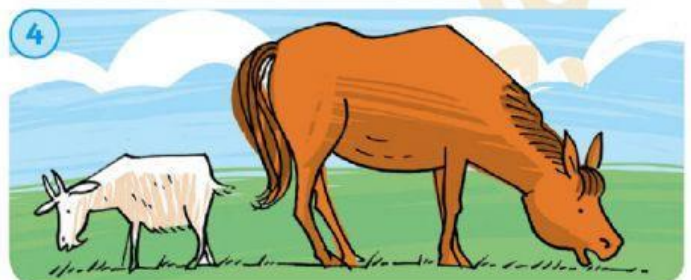
