An  is in charge of ensuring the safety and effectiveness of a process, system, or product. They invent, design, build, analyze and test machines, systems complex structures, etc.

A  is usually a very dedicated and hard-working student because those in the area of legal studies must read tons of books on a wide variety of human-related topics: business, economics, politics, the environment, human rights, international relations and trade.

A  helps develop new medical breakthroughs that benefit humanity. This job involves a great deal of research and performing clinical trials to find out the effects of new drugs and vaccines.

A  is responsible for the coding, design and layout of a website according to a company's / person's specifications. As the role takes into consideration user experience and function, both graphic design and computer programming are necessary.

A  interprets written or spoken material into one or more other languages, ensures meaning and context are maintained, creates glossaries or term dictionaries and works with individual clients and corporations.

A  is an entry-level plumber working under the guidance of a more experienced tradesman. Apprentice plumbers perform different tasks, including installing new plumbing fixtures, unclogging plumbing systems, and repairing pipes.

A  helps customers with purchases and deals with merchandising, restocking shelves and sales. They may also be responsible for setting up displays and keeping up the store appearance.

A  works to maintain, promote and restore the health of patients while following the procedures of the hospital where she/he is gaining

practical experience. A student nurse must follow the instructions of her/his clinical instructor.

Among many things, a  deals with allocating budget resources, formulating policies, coordinating business operations, monitoring and motivating staff, ensuring good customer service, improving administration processes, hiring and training employees, etc.

A  (Chief Technology Officer) acts as the organization's technological thought leader. CTOs oversee all technological processes and analyze performance metrics.

A  does physical work on construction sites. They may prepare sites by cleaning them, loading or unloading materials and removing hazards.

A  is responsible for the preoperative diagnosis of the patient, for performing the operation, and for providing the patient with postoperative surgical care and treatment.

Your day-to-day as a  includes performing surgeries on injured animals, treating wounds, neutering animals, applying vaccines and prescribing medicine.

A  earns a living driving a truck and transporting goods to different locations. They typically go to and from retail and distribution centres or manufacturing plants.

An  works on electrical equipment and in homes, factories, businesses, and buildings to install, repair and maintain power, lighting and communications.

As second in command, a  is responsible for running the kitchen, especially in the absence of the executive chef.
