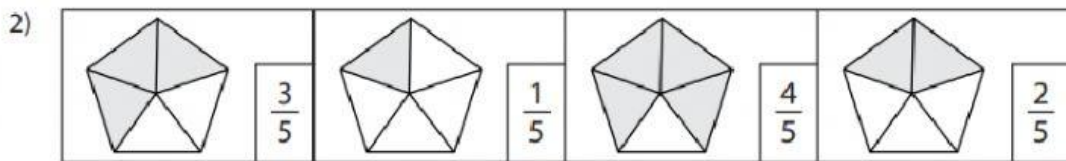
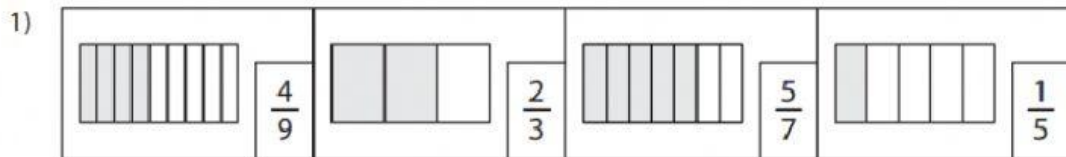

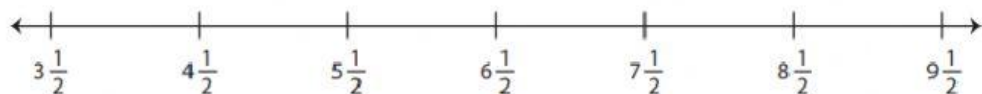
Order the fractions from largest to smallest.



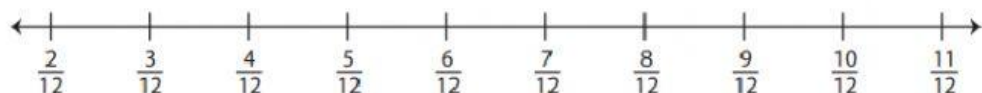
