PAST SIMPLE- USES

-I went there last summer	Finished actions, that happened once or + in the past
-I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they went	Same form
-I played	regular -ed
-I didn't	negative form
-Did I infin.	Question form
-Remember the order using: ASI: <u>Auxiliary+Subject+Infinitive</u> or <u>QuASI: Question</u> <u>Word+Auxiliary+Subject+Infinitive</u>	Did you go?
