Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
good bad	better (than) worse ()	the best worst

3) Read the information:

Use	Form	
We use the comparative form of adjectives to compare two people or things :	To form the comparative of LONG adjectives, we use more + adjective + (than):	
Argentina is more beautiful than Uruguay.	beautiful> more beautiful (than) expensive> more expensive (than)	

Use	Form	
We use the superlative form of adjectives to compare three or more people or things:	To form the superlative of LONG adjectives, we use the most + adjective:	
Argentina is the most beautiful country in South America.	beautiful> the most beautiful expensive> the most expensive	

Here, we are comparing Argentina with all the countries in South America.

Good and bad are IRREGULAR adjectives:

We don't add -er or -est at the end, or we don't use "more" or "the most". They have special words:

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
good	better (than)	the best
bad	worse (than)	the worst

Examples:

Dogs are better than cats.

Fish are the best pets of all.

My brother is bad at basketball, but I'm worse than him.

Our sister is the worst of the three.


