**present tense verb *be* +**

Full form	Contraction
I am your teacher.	I'm your teacher.
You are in room 13.	You're in room 13.
He is James.	He's James.
She is Marta.	She's Marta.
It is a school.	It's a school.
We are students.	We're students.
You are in Class 2.	You're in Class 2.
They are teachers.	They're teachers.

- Use capital *I*. *I'm your teacher.* NOT *i'm*.
- you* = singular and plural.
- Use *he* for a man, *she* for a woman, and *it* for a thing.
- Use *they* for people and things.
- In contractions *'* = a missing letter, e.g. *'m* = *am*.
- Use contractions in conversation.

He / She / It is not	He / She / It isn't	Spanish.
We are not	We aren't	British.
You are not	You aren't	
They are not	They aren't

- Put *not* after the verb to make negatives -.
- You can also contract *are not* and *is not* like this:  
*You are not Italian.* – *You're not Italian.*  
*She is not Polish.* – *She's not Polish.*

- In questions, put *be* before *you*, *he*, etc.  
*Are you Spanish?* NOT *You are Spanish?*  
*Where are you from?* NOT *Where you are from?*  
 Don't use contractions in  short answers.  
*Are you Scottish?* Yes, *I am.* NOT *Yes, I'm.*
