The Stone Age was a time in prehistory when humans made and used stone tools. Scientists divide the Stone Age into 2 main periods: the Paleolithic Period and the Neolithic period.

During the Paleolithic Period (the old stone age), people were nomads, which means they didn't live in one place. They constantly moved to search for animals to hunt. As they were hunters and gatherers, they needed to follow animals to capture them, and at the same time they collected wild fruits they found on their way. They lived in tribes in small groups formed by families. They sheltered in caves and painted on the wall. Paleolithic men and women wore animal skins which they had hunted previously, and they made tools such as axes and spears out of stone.

The Neolithic Period (the new stone age) began about 10,000 years ago. During this period, people stopped being nomads. They became sedentary and built villages. They learned to grow crops and to tame animals. They started to make pottery and weaved cloth and baskets.
