-You **musn't** light a fire in the forest



Prohibited

### HAVE TO - USES

-You **have to do** your homework



Rules (school, business)

-I **have to** stop at the traffic signal



Law (traffic...)

-I **have to do** the reports



External obligation (si no lo haces habrá consecuencias)

### DON'T HAVE TO - USES

-You **don't have to** come in disguise



No obligation  
No necessity
