### THEME 3 – A SHOPPING TRIP – LESSON 5

#### Task 1 – Do the puzzle.

A crossword puzzle grid with 6 numbered clues. The grid is composed of light blue squares. The clues are:

- 1 Across: e \_ \_ \_
- 2 Across: t \_ \_ i \_ t
- 3 Down: \_ \_ \_ \_ \_
- 4 Across: d \_ \_ e \_ \_
- 5 Down: c \_ \_ \_ f
- 6 Down: \_ \_ \_ \_ \_

The corresponding clothing items are:

- 1: A blue T-shirt with a yellow tag labeled '15\$'.
- 2: A green T-shirt.
- 3: A red hat with a yellow bow.
- 4: A red dress.
- 5: A red shirt and a blue shirt hanging on a rack, with tags labeled '100\$' and '5\$' respectively.
- 6: A green and yellow striped scarf.

#### Task 2 – Choose the correct answer.

- a) ( How many / How much ) is the blue T-shirt? It's 15 dollars.
- b) ( Whose / Who ) dress is this? It's Jenny's dress.
- c) ( How / When ) do I get to the flea market? Turn left at the traffic lights.
- d) ( Where / What ? do you do before Tet? Before Tet, I go to the market to buy flowers and decorate my house.
- e) ( Who / Whose ) is calling, please? It's Tony.
- f) ( When / Where ) is the park? Turn right at the corner.
- g) ( Where / Why ) does a monkey live? A monkey lives in a jungle.

h) ( How much / How many ) giraffes are there in the zoo? There is a giraffe in the zoo.

i) (What / When ) did you do in the summer? I went to the beach.

j) ( When / Why ) do you like learning English? Because I like watching English movies.
