

Simple Past vs Modal + have + Past Participle.

1.- You went to the party. at the end you fail the exam. (must)

2.- I ate chines food, I felt very bad. (should)

3.- You didn't pass the course 7B, you didn't study the verbs. (could)

4.- Mark didn't do the homework because he watched T.V. last night. (should)

5.- I could buy those shoes but I didn't have money. (could)

6.- She didn't want to talk about the problem, she didn't want listening to me. (would)

7.- I wanted to study at University, I didn't have any opportunity. (should)

8.- Mr. Smith hit him last night, he lost the control. (should)

9.- She was so beautiful at the party; I couldn't dance with her. (must)

10.- My sister lost her job because she got late at the office. (should)

11.- I got blue when I saw her with her new boyfriend. (must)

12.- In 1985 we didn't have any knowledge about earthquake, we did what we could do.
(must)

13.- Vicky was very happy with him, I was only her friend. (could)

14.- You were very drunk at the party, you opened the refrigerator and said "I want to go to Narnia" (should)

15.- Alexandra was happy with me until she met a handsome man. (must)

16.- I went to the party, she was dancing with another handsome boy. (should)

17.- My lovely teacher didn't sleep because he prepared the lesson to us. (must)

18.- I didn't pass the course 7B because I was absent to the class. (would)

19.- You didn't understand the lesson because you were asleep in the class. (Must)

20.- She got married with him, I couldn't talk with her. (should)
