6. You tell the customer that the place where you try on the clothes is over there. What expression do you use?

7. You ask the customer how many different items of clothing they would like to try on. What expression do you use?

8. You ask the customer if they need a different size. What expression do you use?

9. You ask the customer if the clothes they tried on are their size and if they like them. What expression do you use?

10. You say you did not like the clothes you tried on and you do not want to buy them. What expression do you use?
