

PAST PERFECT

	PAST PERFECT
USE	The first action finished before the second past action.
FORM	Action 1: Past perfect S + had + Vpast participle + C Action 2: simple past
TIME MARKERS	- When - Until - Because - Before - After - By the time (+simple past)
EXAMPLE:	My classmates had left the class when I finished the test. <div style="text-align: right; margin-right: 100px;"> Dependant clause </div>
When the dependent clause comes first, we must use a comma (,) between the clauses.	When I finished the test, my classmates had left the class.
