- Next the Queen hurried and she decided to go across the bridge.



2. Read the text and describe the pictures.


The Queen drove the bus to Tower Bridge.

The Queen was not amused. "Why not?" she asked.




"I'm sorry, Your Majesty," said the bridge keeper, "but a ship needs to pass under the bridge."

"One . . .


two . . .
