How late is late?

When you go to a meeting, how do you decide when to leave to get there? Do you leave early, on time, or late? Your answer may be determined by where you live. In some cultures, it's rude to be late to a meeting or dinner. In other cultures, it's rude to arrive on time or early.

In Switzerland, when a train is scheduled to arrive at seven o'clock, the train will be there on time. You can plan around the arrival time of the train. If you are late, you will have to catch the next train.

In the United States, people expect things to happen on time. When people in the United States plan a meeting, they expect people to be on time. Fifteen minutes late might be OK; an hour late is not. People in the United States plan their day around things happening on time.

In Brazil, people aren't as worried about being on time. It is not considered rude to be half an hour or an hour late to a meeting. People in Brazil don't worry about schedules and punctuality as much as people in some other cultures.



Africa is even more relaxed about time. In West Africa, two hours late is considered on time. They say that they exist in time, not for time. They are more interested in their lives than in schedules.
