

HAVE THE CAUSATIVE USE - Part 1

HAVE something **DONE**
-ed/3rd C

Why "causative"?

Because we ask for, request, demand, etc. a service.

We cause something to happen.

Typical Situations:

a.- Requesting somebody's services

I had the manual translated into Chinese.

I'm having my car fixed next Monday, so I'll be working from home.

vs. I'm going to fix my car. Remember. I'm not a mechanic.)

I've dropped my phone. I need to have it fixed asap!

vs. I'll fix my phone. No way!)

I'm thinking of having my office wallpapered. What color should I choose?

vs. I'm thinking of wallpapering my office. It'll definite be cheaper, but will it look nice?

In more **casual/daily** situations, "get" replaces "have".

I should get my hair cut. It's way too long.

b.- Accidents/Crimes/Unpleasant Situations

I've had my jeans torn so many time while climbing that I should get a new pair.
