$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

2. There are 2 cars. Each car has 4 tires. How many tires are there altogether?

3. There are 4 boy and each boy has 2 cupcakes. How many cupcakes are there in total?

4. 5 boys are playing with their toy cars. Each boy has 3 toy cars. Total how many toy cars are there with the boys?

5. 4 girls have 2 red frocks. How many red frocks are there altogether?
