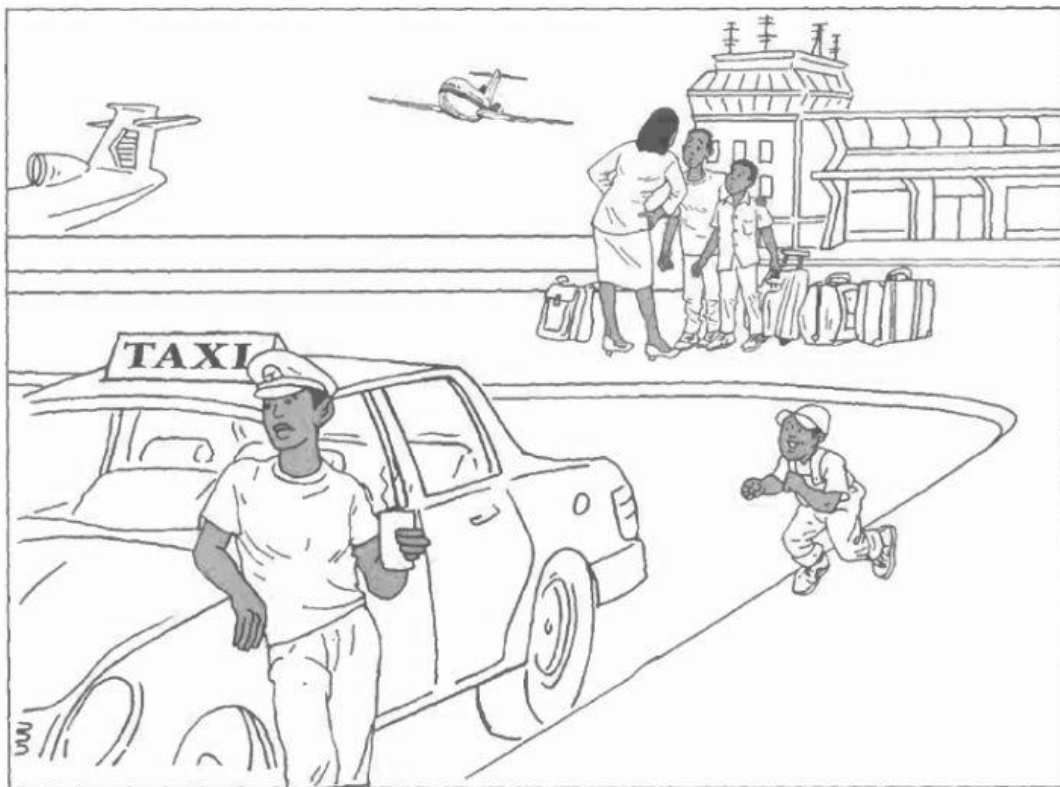

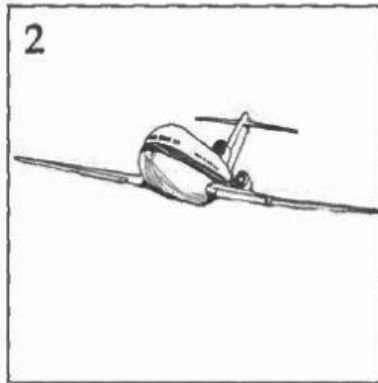

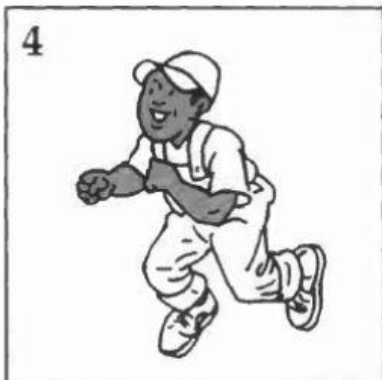

Clifton is three years old. He is with his mother and two brothers.



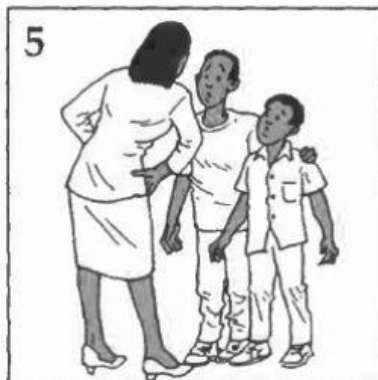

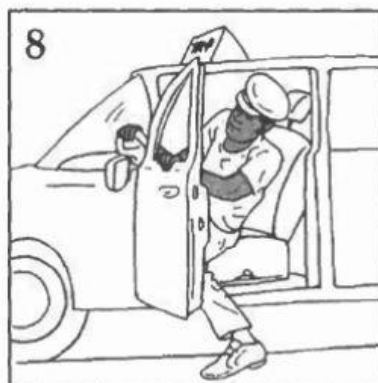

Then the taxi driver gets in the taxi.



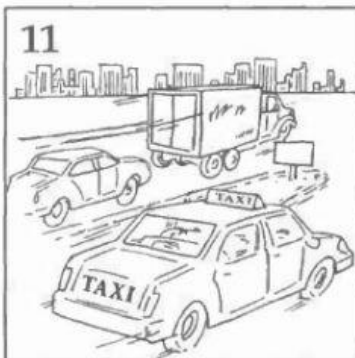

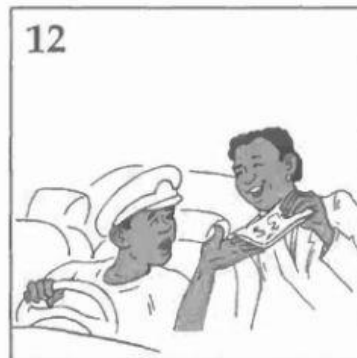
The woman thinks, "The little boy is with the taxi driver. He is his son."

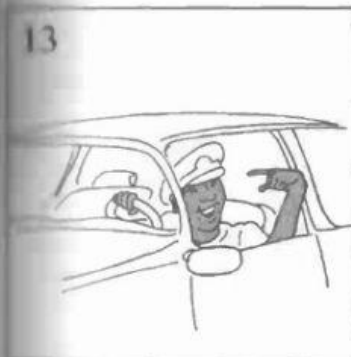
The taxi driver drives for 30 minutes.

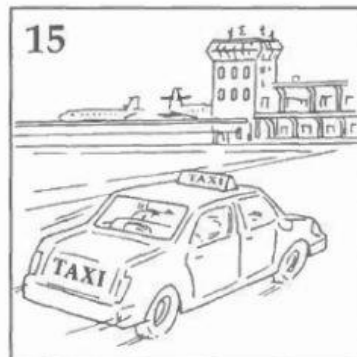
"Wait!" the taxi driver says. "Don't forget your son."

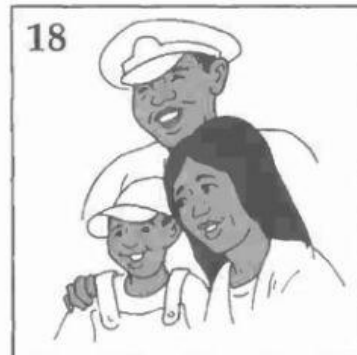
The taxi driver sees Clifton's mother. She is crying and talking to the police.
