


Plants are very important for life in our planet. Plants give us...

fix the plant to the ground.


..produce seeds.

3. Read and write trees, bushes or grasses.

Trees have a thick hard stem called a trunk. They can be deciduous or evergreen.

Bushes have a thick hard stem with low branches.

Grasses are thin and flexible and usually short.



4. Read and complete this diagram about photosynthesis.

Plants make their own food through a process called **photosynthesis**. Plants use **CO2** (from the air), **sunlight** and **water and minerals** (from the soil) to produce **glucose** (food) and **oxygen**.
