

**ANOTHER** means: one more, an additional, an extra; a different one; an alternative one

**Another + Singular Countable noun:**

He bought **another motorbike**. Would you like **another cup** of coffee?

Don't worry about the rain. We can go **another day**. I think you should paint it **another colour**.

**Another + One:**

I loved the sandwiches. Can I have **another one**, please? (= an additional sandwich)

A: You can borrow more of these books if you want. B: Ok, I'll take **another one**. (= another book)

**Another + number + plural noun** (a couple of, a few etc.):

In **another 20 years** my laptop is going to be obsolete. I'm going to spend **another three days** here.

They gave him **another couple** of **months** to finish the sculpture.

**OTHER** goes before plural countable and uncountable nouns or even a \*singular noun.

**Other + Plural Countable/Uncountable Noun:**

We have **other sizes** if you need. Have you got any **other information** about the incident?

Some days are sunny, **other days** can be very rainy. I got some **other news** on the radio.

I can't help you because I'm busy with **other things**.

**Other + Ones:**

We don't need those numbers, we need **other ones**. (= different numbers)

A: You can borrow my notes if you want. B: Thanks, but I need **other ones**. (= other notes)

**The + other + one** (singular):

I don't know about this colour, I like **the other one** better. I need the email, but not this one, **the other one!**

**OTHERS** (pronoun) replaces "other ones" or "other + plural noun".

I don't like these postcards. Let's ask for **others**. (others = other postcards)

Some of the employees arrived on Monday, **others** arrived the following day. (others = other employees)

**The others**

He has interviewed two candidates, but he insists on interviewing **the others**. (= other candidates)

What are **the others** doing tonight? (= other people)
