SIMPLE PAST AND PAST PROGRESSIVE

Use the past progressive to express an action that was in progress at a certain time in the past. This action could be interrupted by another action, which is expressed in the simple past. We form the past progressive with the verb *to be* in simple past and the *-ing* form of the verb. To mix these two tenses in a sentence, use *when* followed by the simple past and *while* followed by the past progressive.

He **was sitting** in the park when it **started** to rain.
While they **were playing** on the computer, the lights **went out**.
