



2- Why we cannot count 206 bones on the diagram of the skeleton above?

3- Match up each role of the skeleton with its evidence.

Supports the body	Bones meet at joints; without these the skeleton would be rigid.
Protects the organs	Blood cells are made in bone marrow, and marrow is found in the middle of some bones.
Allows movements	Animals without a skeleton cannot hold themselves up.
Produces blood cells	Some bones are shaped to fit around an organ, such as the skull and ribcage.
