MODALS FOR ADVICE, SUGGESTIONS, AND PREDICTIONS

We use the modals *should* and *could* to give advice and suggestions, among other uses. We use the modals *will*, *may*, and *might* to make predictions. *Will* expresses more certainty while *may* and *might* express a possibility. Modal verbs are always followed by a verb in simple form.

You **shouldn't** be mean to others.
It **could** be a better option.
You **will** get the job. I'm sure!
It **may** be difficult to explain.
