A. NARRATIVES (telling a story, a joke, a plot or sports commentaries)	A. DESCRIBING PICTURES
B. ROUTINES & HABITS	B. PERSONAL PLANS AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE FUTURE *we can control the future event
C. TIMETABLED EVENTS IN THE FUTURE *we cannot control the future event	C. ACTIONS THAT ARE IN PROGRESS AT/AROUND THE TIME OF SPEAKING
D. GENERAL TRUTHS	D. ACTIONS THAT ARE TEMPORARY (X2)
E. PERMANENT STATES	E. SITUATIONS THAT ARE CHANGING/DEVELOPING IN THE PRESENT
	F. AN ANNOYING HABIT (often with <i>ALWAYS, CONTINUALLY, CONSTANTLY</i> and <i>FOREVER</i> )
