Prince Philip has made rude remarks about 'foreigners' in the past. Recently, the Queen's grandson Prince Harry and his wife Meghan Markle left the UK to go and live in California. They have given an interview with Oprah Winfrey. There is scandal about Prince Andrew and his links with unsuitable people. However, the Queen's popularity is never in question. Even Republicans, that is, people who want to abolish the monarchy, respect her. Until the Covid-19 epidemic, the Queen was very busy, travelling the country. She still contributes to public life. She recently encouraged everybody to have the Covid vaccination. She stood by Ukraine and supported us!
