What are adjectives?

- An **adjective** is a word that describes an animal, person or thing e.g. The **fluffy** dog, The **old** man, The **tall** building.
- **Adjectives** include words that describe what something looks like and what it feels like to touch, taste, or smell e.g. A **beautiful** flower, The **smooth** paper, A **sour** lolly, **Burnt** toast smells yuck.
- **Adjectives** can be colours or words that describe temperatures and sizes e.g. The **chilly** wind, A **tiny** insect.
