Workplace protective clothing

Many companies provide their workers with protective clothes because they are aware of the importance of worker's health and safety at work. Protective clothes in the workplace refer to the coveralls, hard hat and safety glasses. They are designed to protect a worker from chemicals, electrical and heat.

There are a lot of workplace risks such as serious electricity risks, fire, chemical and dangerous machinery which can harm workers. Moreover, there are other unseen risks that do not cause an immediate problem, but can cause problems to an employee's ears, eyes, face and body.

Because they usually do their tasks in a high-risk environment, eye injuries can occur in a workplace, so workers need to wear face shields to protect their eyes from chemical, dust or gas. For both eye and respiratory protection, a full face is recommended. Foot injuries occur from falls and slips. The type of floor in a workplace influences the comfort and safety of workers. A slippery floor can cause accidents. Comfortable safety boots provide adequate protection for both men and women. Using heavy equipment such as hammers, saws or working in a garage might impact on worker's hands. As such, it's important to wear the correct type of work gloves to prevent short and long-term workplace injuries.
