## What Is Plastic?

Plastic is a material made by humans. It cannot be found in the natural world. Lots of everyday items that humans use are made from plastic.

## Good Things About Plastic

Plastic can be a very useful material. There are many reasons that humans use it to make so many products.

- It's strong.
- It is very durable so plastic items last a very long time.
- It can be moulded into almost any shape.
- It can be made waterproof.
- It can be made in different colours.
- Plastic food packaging stops air from getting inside, which helps to keep food fresh for longer.
- It is much easier to clean than other materials, like fabric or wood.



## The Problem with Plastic

Lots of plastic pollution is getting into the oceans. Plastic does not break down like natural materials, such as apples or wood. Because it is so durable, the plastics that humans have made can exist for hundreds of years!

Plastic can harm animals living in the water and on the beach. The animals can get tangled up in plastic bags, fishing nets or strings. If animals eat pieces of plastic, there is no room in their bellies for real food. This is also a problem for humans! When we ingest fish or seafood, we might be eating tiny bits of ocean plastic.

### What Can Humans Do?

#### Reduce



Try to use less plastic in your daily life. You could use a bamboo toothbrush instead of a plastic one. Eat your meals with metal cutlery. What else could you swap?

#### Reuse



Take your own bags to the shops so you can avoid getting a new plastic one. Try buying your plastic toys from a charity shop so that fewer new plastic toys need to be made. What else could you reuse?

#### Recycle



Sort your rubbish so that the plastic can be recycled. It will be used to make new plastic products so that less fresh plastic is created. How much could you sort each week?

#### Keep It Clean!



If you visit the beach, make sure all of your litter goes into the bin. With a grown-up, could you do a beach clean-up?
