Past simple (was / were) (Pupil's Book page 111)

I was with Grandma. **I wasn't** at home.
She was happy. **She wasn't** tired.
We were in the kitchen. **We weren't** hungry.
wasn't → was **not** weren't → were **not**

Past simple to be: question and short answers (Pupil's Book page 115)

Were you at home yesterday? **Yes, I was.** / **No, I wasn't.**
Were you in the dining room? **Yes, we were.** / **No, we weren't.**
