

Past simple - Regular verbs**Remember!**

- Use the past simple to talk about finished actions in the past.
- To make the past simple of (+) regular verbs we add *ed* to the verb

Did	I/you/he/she we/they	play	football?	Yes	I/you/he/she we/they	did.	(+)
				No,		didn't.	(-)

Past simple – irregular verbs

The form of the past simple is the same for all subjects (I / you / he / she / it / we / they).

	(+)	(-)
Infinitive	Past simple	Past simple
to get	got	didn't get
to make	made	didn't make
to eat	ate	didn't eat
to go	went	didn't go
to do	did	didn't do
to cut	cut	didn't cut

(?)							
Did	I / you / he she / we / they	buy	a magazine yesterday ?	Yes,	I / you / he / she / we / they	did.	(+)
				No,		didn't.	(-)
