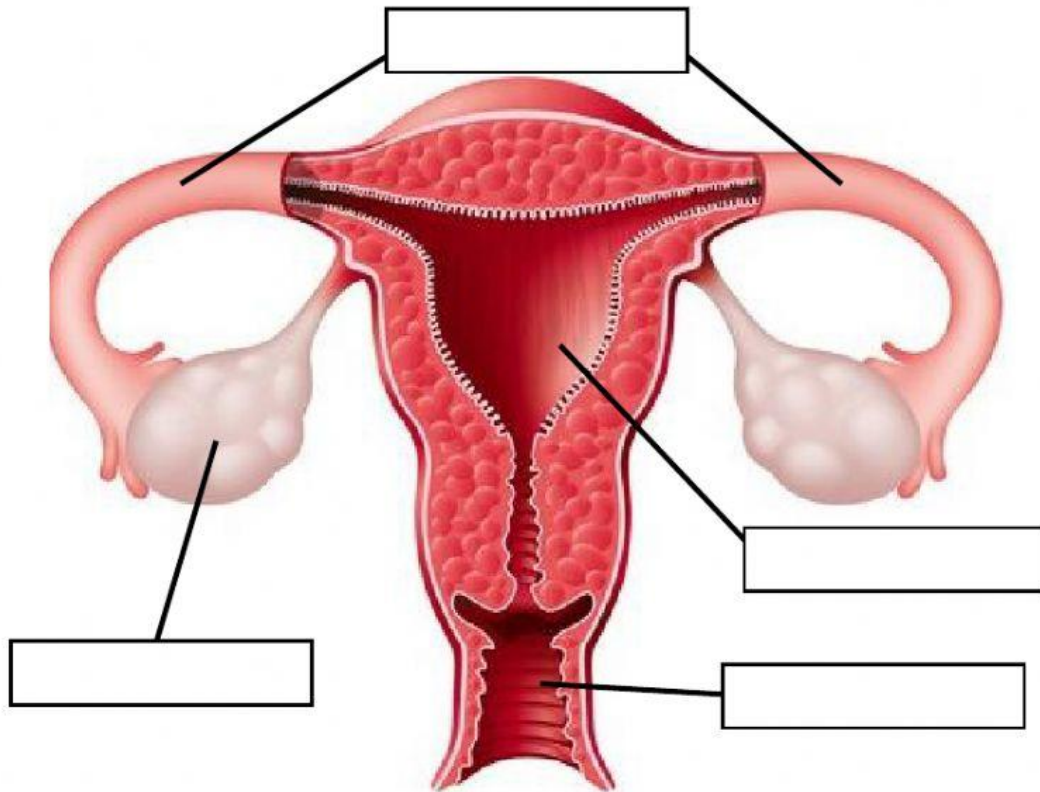


1. Label the different parts of the female reproductive system. Write all the names using small letters.



2. Here you have the functions of the different parts. Write the names in the correct part. Use small letters.

- Their role is *producing the female sex hormones* that control reproduction and *the female eggs* (called ova) for possible fertilization.
- They serve as pathways for the ova (egg cells) to travel from the ovaries to the uterus. Fertilization of an egg by a sperm normally occurs in this part.
- Also commonly known as the '*womb*', is responsible for the development of the embryo and fetus during pregnancy.
- In childbirth it expands to provide a channel for delivery of a newborn from the uterus.
