In this unit, you will learn about Section 1 of the IELTS Listening test and practise the skills you need to answer five-option multiple-choice questions. The topic of this unit is libraries.

In IELTS Listening test, Section 1 the conversation is always with **two** speakers, and five-option multiple choice questions may test your ability to understand specific details (e.g. *the health benefits of doing yoga* or *times when you can visit a local gym*) or the main ideas or opinions you hear (e.g. *I think yoga is a better form of EXERCISE than lifting weights*).

When you listen to the conversation, it is useful to understand the roles of each speaker (e.g. *teacher and student* or *shop assistant and customer*).
