PRESENT SIMPLE: We use it to talk about facts and routines.

+ S + v (-s/-es/-ies) + c

Ex. I go to school / She goes to school

- S + don't/d 't + inf. v + c

Ex. I don't study / He doesn't study

? Do/Does + s + inf. v + c + ?

Ex. Do you wear red tights?

Yes, I do / No, I don't

PRESENT CONTINUOUS: We use it to describe actions that are happening at the moment.

+ S _____ + verb TO BE + verb-ing + c _____.

Ex. I am writing the grammar

- Subject + verb TO BE + NOT + v ___-ing + c

Ex. I am N writing the grammar

? Am/Are + sub _____ + verb-ing + c _____?

Ex. Are you singing?

Yes, I am / No, I am not

TOO & NOT ENOUGH WITH ADJECTIVES:

Too = Demasiado - Before the adjective

Ex. The tower is t ___ big - La torre es demasiado grande

Not Enough = "No lo suficiente" - After the adjective

Ex. The music is not e _____ loud
