Listening Strategy: Keywords

Keywords help identify what is important in a sentence.

1. What Are Keywords?

Keywords are often nouns and verbs. They tell you the most important information in a sentence. Don't try to catch every word being said.

Imagine a conversation in which you hear *New York, business trip, last year*. You missed all the other words. But you heard all the important words! You can understand that the person is speaking about a business trip to New York last year. That is enough to answer a question!

Ex1 The **flight** was **canceled** due to **bad weather**.

Flight, canceled, and bad weather tell us what happened and why.

We can use these keywords to answer the following questions:

What was canceled?	The flight
What happened to the flight?	Canceled
Why was the flight canceled?	Bad weather

Ex2 The **train departs** at **five o'clock**.

Train, departs, five o'clock tell us what and when.

We can use these keywords to answer the following questions:

What departs at five o'clock?	The train
What time does the train depart?	At five o'clock
What happens at five o'clock?	The train departs.

2. Types of Keywords

Keywords can include all of the following:

- **Names:** people, places, buildings, countries
- **Title:** jobs, official titles
- **Time words:** days, dates, hours
- **Numbers:** ages, telephone numbers, addresses
- **Actions:** verbs of action

Ex Call two days ahead for discount flights.	(time words)
Check in at the departure desk for your connecting flight.	(place name)
Carts can be rented from the ticket counter .	(place name)
Jake bought me a plane ticket.	(person's name)
The plane will be departing in 15 minutes .	(time words)
Please take off your shoes and walk through the metal detector .	(item name)
Suitcases arrive at baggage claim shortly after the plane lands .	(time words)
Hand your ticket to the conductor when you get on the train.	(job)
