

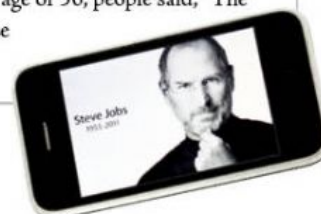

STEVE JOBS

Steve Jobs was a computer programmer, inventor and businessman. Jobs was born on 24th February, 1955 in the US. He began university, but stopped after six months. When Jobs was 21 years old, he and his friend Steve Wozniak started Apple Computers. They worked in Jobs' garage. Their user-friendly personal computers were very successful and they sold many of them. At the age of 25, Jobs was a multimillionaire. He didn't actually invent the iPod, iPhone and iPad, but he helped change the world of computers, music and communication forever. When he died on 5th October, 2011, at the age of 56, people said, "The world is a better place because of him."



Language

When writing a biography, we often use *was / were* and the Past Simple to write about the person's life. We often use possessive adjectives and **object pronouns** (*me, you, him, her, it, us, them*) to avoid repeating the names of people, places and things.

Sue **gave him** a book about Bill Gates.

It **was her** book.

He **read it** and **returned it to her**.
