### INTERROGATIVE

Was	I	famous?
Were	you	
Was	he / she / it	
Were	we	
Were	you	
Were	they	

### (+) SHORT ANSWER

Yes,	I was.
	you were.
	he / she / it was.
	we were.
	you were.
	they were.

### (-) SHORT ANSWER

No,	I wasn't.
	you weren't.
	he / she / it wasn't.
	we weren't.
	you weren't.
	they weren't.
