## Compare the Manuals

### HOW TO WASH YOUR HAIR

- First of all, use warm water to rinse your hair. warm water is good to clean and remove the dirt trapped in the hair.
- Put a small amount of shampoo if you have short hair. It will keep your hair healthy, smoother and shiny.
- Lather up the scalp. Because the hair closest to the scalp is the youngest, it is better to wash the hair from the roots to ends.
- Rub your hair gently. Rubbing the hair too harshly may damage it permanently.
- Rinse your hair with cold water. This will help your hair shine better and shut up the follicles tight.

### HOW TO WASH YOUR HANDS

- Wet your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), turn off the tap, and apply soap
- Lather your hands by rubbing them together with the soap. Lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.
- Scrub your hands for at least 20 seconds. Need a timer? Hum the "Happy Birthday" song from beginning to end twice.
- Rinse your hands well under clean, running water.
- Dry your hands using a clean towel or air dry them.
