I promise," said Cinderella.

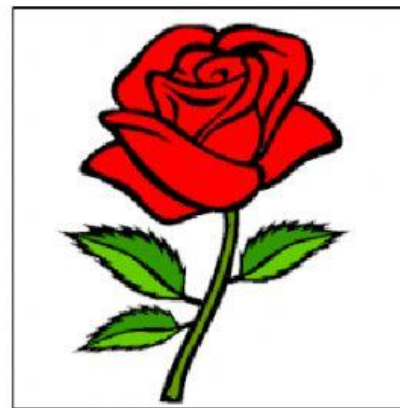
