

# Adjectives and adverbs

## Adjectives

*a symbol of the difficult, stormy nature of love*

*she looks calm and content*

## Adverbs

*Look carefully and you'll notice that ...*

*These may look like fairly conventional, fairly realistic pieces,*

*Sadly, though, he died at the age of 37.*

- 1 Adjectives are often used *before / after* nouns.  
Adjectives are also often used *before / after* the verbs *be, look, become, seem, get, taste, etc.* to describe the subject of the verb.
- 2 Most adverbs are formed by adding \_\_\_\_\_ to the adjective, but some have the same form as the adjective: *fast, hard* and *later*. Adverbs can be used to modify verbs, \_\_\_\_\_, other adverbs and whole clauses or sentences.
